Our office will be bringing live young livestock animals to your school. The animal species may be pigs, goats, sheep, cows, chickens, and ducks.

This is offered for Kindergarten, First, and Second grades. The animals will be outside and the class will come out for 30 minute sessions and learn what each animal is, what it is called, what it eats, and what products we get from them.

This is not a petting zoo. The students will be able to touch and interact with the animals if they choose.

I will then contact you when the school year (2010-2011) begins, and give you the date and time that we will be coming to your school. It will be a date within September 20th-24th.
