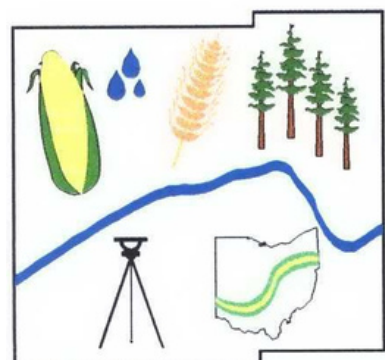
Raspberries, Corn, Rhubarb, and Asparagus Oh My!
