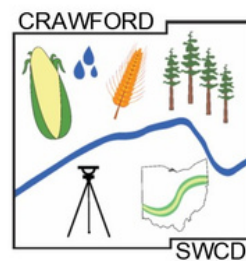


Crawford Soil and Water Conservation District 81st Annual Meeting

Presenting on the Increase of Tornadoic Activity in Ohio:

DR. JANA HOUSER, PH.D.

Associate Professor & Director of Undergraduate Studies,
Department of Geography, The Ohio State University



Dr. Houser's primary research focus is utilizing state-of-the-art mobile radar technology to track tornadoes and supercell thunderstorms, particularly evaluating the tornado formation process.

She received a B.S. in meteorology from Penn State University, and an M.S. and Ph.D. both in meteorology from the University of Oklahoma; where she studied under the mentorship of renowned severe weather expert Dr. Howard Bluestein. She is the decorated recipient of numerous awards in the area of meteorology studying weather structure, atmospheric rivers in California, and tornado rotation. Dr. Houser has three daughters and keeps herself occupied with her kid's extracurricular activities, her pets, outdoor pursuits, gardening and fitness.
